As well as being practical and smart, we believe that a sensible uniform policy will reinforce a positive learning environment as well as promote a unified school spirit and inspire a sense of pride in John Ray Infant School. It is our policy that all children wear uniform that complies with this policy when attending or representing our school in an organised event, either during or outside normal school hours (unless activity does not permit this.)

The Role of Parents/Carers

We expect all parents/carers who send their children to John Ray Infant School to ensure that they comply with the requirements of the school's uniform policy. Parents/carers are also expected to send their children to school in clothing this is clean, well-fitting, and well-presented.

School Uniform Suppliers

Parents/carers may choose to purchase items of school uniform with or without the school logo. All uniform can be sourced from multiple best value shops, and, for non-logo items, the school does not recognise or endorse a particular supplier. For parents/carers who do wish to purchase items with the school logo on them, our Logo supplier is School Trends. The link is also available via our school website.

Pre-loved uniform

We support the use of pre-loved items and good condition school uniform items that are no longer required can be donated to the school. The school will distribute these where they see fit and some may be sold from the school office.

School uniform items

- Red sweatshirt or cardigan (Compulsory) Logo or Non Logo
- White shirt or polo shirt (Compulsory) Logo or Non Logo
- Grey or black skirt/trousers (compulsory)
- Red and white summer dresses (Optional)
- Black, flat sturdy shoes no trainers or boots (Compulsory)
- White short sleeved T Shirt for indoor PE (Compulsory) Logo or Non Logo
- Black shorts (Compulsory)
- Plimsolls/Trainers for indoor and outdoor PE (Compulsory)
- Black jogging bottoms and sweatshirt for outdoor PE (Compulsory)
- Book bag and PE kit bag (Optional) Logo school bag can be purchased from the school
 office.

Brands and slogans

Cardigans and sweatshirts should not have visible Brands or Slogans.

Jewellery and make up

For health and safety reasons we do not allow children to wear jewellery to school, with an exception made for:

- Simple watches that only tell the time and will not cause distress if lost due to value
- Simple earring studs in pierced ears but will need to be removed and not taped on PE days
- · Small objects of religious significance

It is essential that children can remove any permitted items of jewellery by themselves for PE lessons to avoid any injuries from occurring. It is the policy from the Local Authority that ear-rings can not be taped for PE lessons, they will need to be removed.

Hair

Where hair is long enough to do so, for health and safety reasons, children are required to tie hair up. If wearing other hair accessories, these should be plain and not overly large. Extreme haircuts or colours are not permitted.

Lost property All items of clothing should be clearly labelled with your child's name as the school cannot accept responsibility for any articles lost or damaged on the school premises. Lost property that is not named is kept for a term in the reception area before being redistributed.
