Foundation Stage Maths

Intent

In FS our intent is to ensure all children develop the skills and knowledge to become confident, articulate and independent mathematicians.

We will ensure that the content, challenge and progression are appropriate for all learners and that the environment in FS supports maths across the curriculum, both inside and outside.

Implementation

In FS Maths is part of our everyday learning and children will always have access to a range of appropriate resources that can both consolidate and enhance their learning.

We will use Maths meetings each week to revisit past learning so that it becomes embedded and the children become confident to use and revisit past learning in their play.

Teaching of specific maths skills and knowledge will be part of our weekly timetable using the White Rose maths scheme. The children will be challenged to use and extend these skills through our enhanced continuous provision.

Impact and Evidence

Our Maths GLD last year was 79%, an increase of 2%.

The impact of FS Maths will be that children develop a deep understanding for a range of mathematical concepts through their everyday play. They will be able to see and understand the practical uses for maths and will be able to share their understanding with others.

Through the use of our Learning Journey wall children will be able to see and understand maths as part of their wider learning. We will be able to show progression and consolidation of knowledge and skills through our personalised online Learning Journal Tapestry posts as well as in our school scrapbook journals each week.
